What is a water budget?

- CVWD uses a water budget-based tiered rate structure that allows for a reasonable amount of water based on each customer's individual needs. Water use that exceeds the water budget is charged a higher rate to discourage wasteful water
- Residential water budgets include an indoor budget and an outdoor budget.
- For commercial customers, the indoor water budget is based on the number of equivalent dwelling units (EDUs) assigned to the property by CVWD when the business was established or repurposed.
- Irrigation customers do not have indoor water use and therefore no indoor water budget.

How are water budgets calculated?

Indoor water budgets (tier 1) are based on national industry standards for four people.

- Default indoor budget for homeowners is 8 ccf.
- Indoor water budgets can be increased for homes with more than four people.

Outdoor water budgets (tier 2) are calculated individually for all residential and large landscape customers based on the following information:

- Size of landscaped area of each parcel
- Historical weather data which will now provide an advanced monthly water use target.
- A plant factor that reflects how much water needs to be applied to a landscape such as grass
- An irrigation efficiency factor

Water budgets are adjusted to reflect the number of days in a billing cycle, which can vary depending on when the meter is read.
