SUPPORT

Dear Assembly Member Bloom:

On behalf of the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California, I am pleased to express "support" for the Spring budget change proposal by the Department of Fish and Wildlife (DFW) to eradicate nutria in California.

The Spring proposal item will provide DFW \$9,384,000 in reimbursement authority over three years for grants from the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Conservancy. The Spring proposal is intended to supplement the Governor's original January budget proposal that provided \$1.949 million in General Fund and 10 positions for the 2019-2020 budget year and \$1.624 million ongoing to eradicate nutria, which the Assembly Budget Subcommittee 3 voted to approve on March 6, 2019.

The current program is operated with one dedicated staff and a budget of \$230,000 a year for statewide management that results in inevitable limitations for effective eradication. A native of South America, nutria have proven to be a formidable and difficult species to successfully eradicate. One of the most common characteristics that complicate control efforts of nutria is the quick and rapid increase in population within a relatively short window of time. In addition, nutria consume large amounts of vegetation and often dig in soil near water for food. As a result, the safety of levees within the

Delta are an inevitable concern that can result in irreversible habitat, agricultural, and water supply impacts with significant statewide ramifications.
