Subject: Palos Verdes Reservoir Rehabilitation

The Metropolitan Water District of Southern California (Metropolitan) will be performing construction activities within 500 feet of your residence as part of the Palos Verdes Reservoir Rehabilitation Project. The Palos Verdes Reservoir provides important operational storage and hydraulic flexibility for Metropolitan's distribution system. This project is a key element of Metropolitan's on-going Infrastructure Reliability Program to ensure our water distribution system continues to provide a reliable water supply to our 26 member agencies that serve 19 million customers.

The scope of the construction work includes upgrading a reservoir drain in the southern portion of the reservoir property. Associated work will include equipment traversing the southern area of the property for access and installation activities, demolition of the existing v-drain, excavation, soil backfilling, re-compaction, and additional construction staff in the vicinity.

This work is scheduled to begin on April 19, 2018 and is anticipated to be completed by May 11, 2018. The work at this location may create an inconvenience due to noise from the equipment necessary for the drain installation. The contractor will make every effort to minimize any inconvenience by following city construction requirements for work hours and truck traffic, which will only be permitted between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

The water supply to homes and/or businesses will not be affected. We ask for your understanding and patience as every effort will be made to minimize the inconveniences from this vital project.
