The Garvey Reservoir is located at 1061 South Orange Avenue in Monterey Park, within Los Angeles County.


**Project Description:**

The Metropolitan Water District of Southern California (Metropolitan) prepared an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for rehabilitation of the Garvey Reservoir in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the CEQA Guidelines. The Project involves various upgrades, replacements, and improvements to Metropolitan facilities located at Garvey Reservoir, including but not limited to, the reservoir floating cover and liner, the inlet/outlet tower, the junction structure, the facility electrical system, the existing standby generator, telemetry equipment associated with the surge tank, the Administration Building and Water Quality Control Laboratory as well as construction of a new pump station facility, and various site improvements. Project construction activities would occur between 2025 and 2027, and 2034 and 2035. Operations and maintenance activities at the Garvey Reservoir would remain similar to existing conditions once construction activities are completed with the exception of an increase in electricity use for pump station operation.

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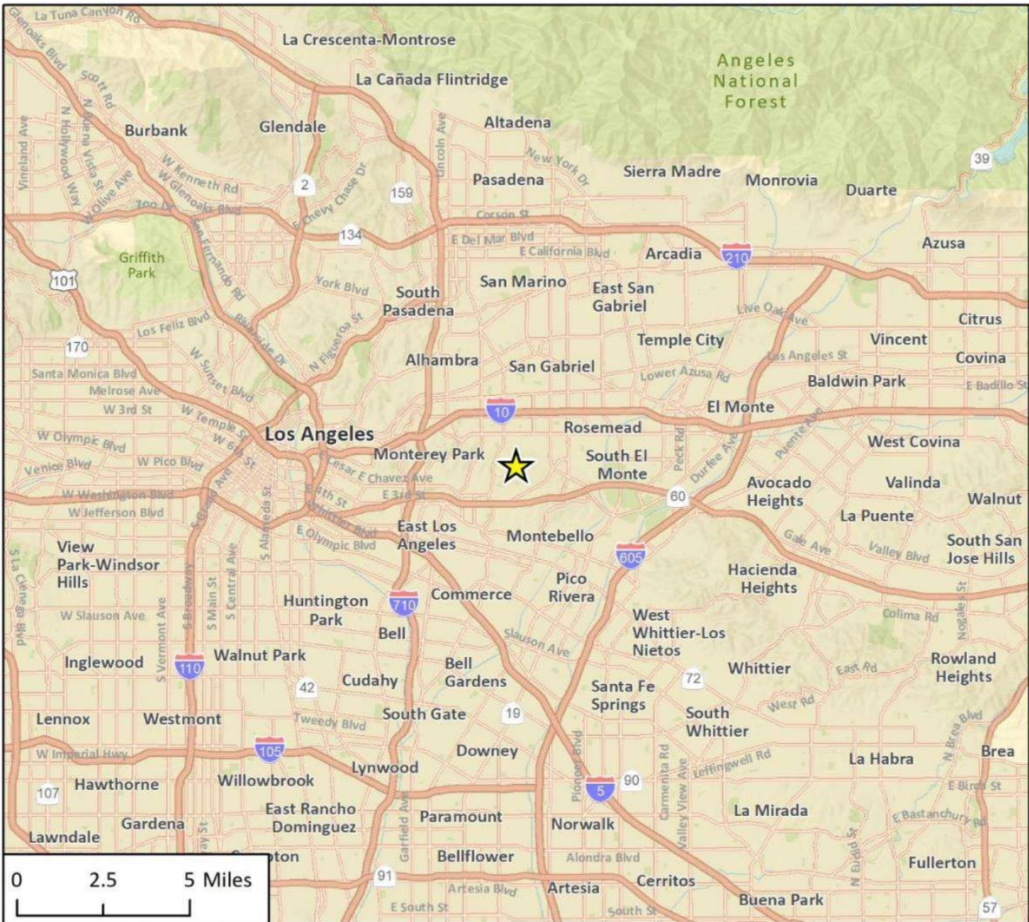

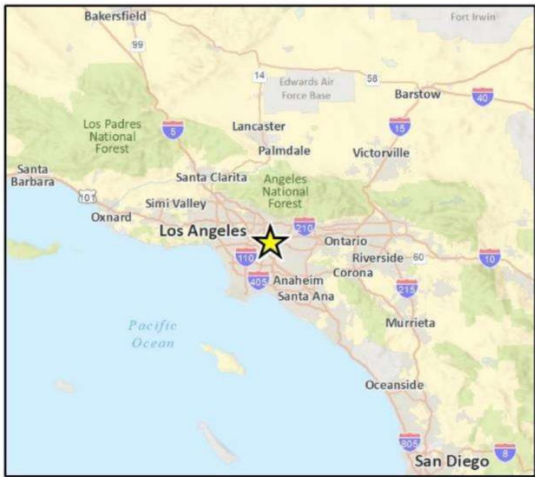


Fig. 2.1 Regional Location
